Friday	Notes:	<p>Objective: For students to learn and practice the skill of using reference to create their own artwork.</p> <p>Lesson Overview: Finish painting rocks.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Students are to paint rocks and use creativity to express something of meaning.
